Difference between "Suspension" and "Termination"

Suspension: No radiation work while registered as a Radiation Worker during a period. Termination: Quitting the registration as a Radiation Worker at KEK Tsukuba Campus.

Procedures for "Suspension" and "Return"

<Suspension of radiation work for one month or longer>

When a radiation worker suspends radiation work for one month or longer due to a business trip or other reasons, submit a "Notification of Suspension to Radiation Worker (Form No.7-1)" to Radiation Control Office.

<Returning from the suspension of radiation work>

When a radiation worker who has suspended radiation work returns to radiation work, submit the "Notification of Return to Radiation Worker (Form No.7-2)" to Radiation Control Office.

Radiation Control Office prepares personal dosimeters based on these notifications. Remember to follow the procedures for suspension and return.

Procedures for "Termination"

<No longer required to be a radiation worker>

No longer required to be a radiation worker for transfer or other reasons, submit "Notification of Termination of Radiation Work (Form No.8)" to Radiation Control Office.

We can issue your accumulated dose and training records. Please contact **Radiation Control**Office if you need this service. There is no Form.

<Tokai Campus worker terminates radiation work at the Tsukuba Campus>

Notify the Tokai campus office of the Applied Research Laboratory of the termination of radiation work at KEK Tsukuba. There is no Form.
