Procedures for Changing Radiation Exposure Control Criteria for Women

Person Concerned

<Change of Exposure Control Criteria>

Female radiation workers at KEK, including visitors, who are "pregnant" or "infertile or who have declared that they have no intention of becoming pregnant."

<Lifting of the change of the radiation exposure control standard>

Persons who have changed the radiation exposure control criteria above and **wish to terminate the change in radiation exposure control criteria**.

Details of changes based on notification

<Pregnant women>

Additional radiation dose limits

Internal exposure: 1 mSv/pregnancy period

Abdominal surface: 2 mSv/pregnancy period

(Pregnancy period = the period from notification to delivery)

Changing of working Level for radiation exposure control

0.3 mSv/day, 0.5 mSv/week, 2.0 mSv/year

==> 0.1 mSv/day, 0.2 mSv/week, 0.7 mSv/year (pregnancy period)

<Those who have declared infertility or no intention to become pregnant> Changing of radiation dose limit

6 mSv/year, 2 mSv/3 months

==> 20 mSv/year

Changing of working Level for radiation exposure control

0.3 mSv/day, 0.5 mSv/week, 2.0 mSv/year ==> 0.5 mSv/day, 1.0 mSv/week, 7.0 mSv/year
